Roma Street station construction site: Weekend work within rail corridor

The Cross River Rail Tunnel & Stations team will be working within the rail corridor near Roma Street station between 11:55pm Friday 10 July and 11:55pm Sunday 12 July 2020.

Details of work

Work to be carried out within the rail corridor during the weekend period will include:

- Installing overhead line structures at platforms 2 and 3
- Modifying and testing signals
- Installing survey monitoring equipment at various platforms
- · Removing materials and waste from the work area.

What to expect

As a result of this work, you can expect:

- Increased levels of localised noise and lighting
- The use of construction machinery such as mobile cranes, elevated work platforms, hand tools, lighting towers and trucks
- Increased construction vehicle movements on local roads and within the rail corridor. The project team will access
 the corridor via existing entry and exit points at Countess Street
- Workers may arrive onsite one hour prior to the planned start time to prepare.

Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for nearby residents and businesses, this includes:

- Ensuring plant and equipment has been maintained appropriately
- Minimising light spill by directing light-generating plant and equipment away from residential areas
- Conducting toolbox talks with workers to reinforce out-of-hours work protocols.

Work hours

This work has been scheduled to fit within a Queensland Rail planned track closure. The majority of the work listed above will occur between **6am and 6pm on Saturday 11 and Sunday 12 July 2020**, however some activities may continue outside these hours.

Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.

Project information
