



November 2020

Albert Street station construction update

Throughout November, works will continue at each of the three Albert Street station construction sites. This includes ongoing excavation for the future main station entrance (Lot 1), ongoing tunnelling activities within the acoustic shed (Lot 2) and demolition of the building structure at 142 Albert Street, the future northern station entrance site (Lot 3).

What to expect

- Construction activity in the area with potential for an increase in noise, dust, vibration, truck movements and workers.
- Construction impact mitigation activities such as street sweepers, water suppression and hoarding installation.
- Ongoing delivery and removal of material, equipment and machinery, including oversized plant.
- Temporary road, laneway and pedestrian traffic detours under the direction of traffic control which may cause delay in journey times and routes.

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LOT 1 - Main station entrance

Western corner of Albert and Mary streets intersection





Excavation of the main station entrance Ongoing

- Excavation and ground retention activities including rock hammering, drilling, shotcreting and rock anchoring
- · Adjustments to site facilities
- Installation of structural steel props

Mary Street pedestrian gantry finishing works November 2020

- Finishing the pedestrian gantry works on the Mary Street footpath alongside Lot 1, including intermittent footpath closures during lifting activities and signage installation
- · Line marking and lane adjustment activities on Mary Street

LOT 2 - Tunnelling site, within the acoustic shed

Northern corner of Albert and Mary streets intersection

Underground excavation within the acoustic shed Ongoing

- Excavation of underground access adits and platform cavern by roadheader and controlled blasting
- Ground stabilisation and retention works including shotcreting and rock bolting

Tunnelling support activities

Ongoing

- Delivery and removal of plant, materials and equipment
- · Acoustic shed finishing works
- Extension activities to ventilation and tunnel services





LOT 3 - Northern station entrance

142 Albert Street

Site establishment

November 2020

- Site and geotechnical investigations
- Service locations and relocations
- Installation and adjustment of barriers, fencing and hoarding, including signage installation
- Installation of site facilities
- · Pedestrian gantry finishing works

Demolition of 142 Albert Street

November 2020

- Installation, adjustment and removal of protective scaffolding
- · Removal of internal fittings and fixtures
- Hazardous material (HAZMAT) inspections, monitoring and removal
- · Disconnection, relocation and removal of existing services
- Demolition of the building structure

Utility work and geotechnical investigations November 2020

- Locating, installing and relocating services
- Geotechnical investigations
- · Borehole drilling and reinstatement works
- · Lane closures and traffic changes, where required

Footpath closure and new pedestrian crossing

November 2020 until construction completion

- Footpath closure on Mary Street alongside Lot 2
- Preparation work and construction of a temporary pedestrian crossing on Mary Street between The Westin and the Quest River Park Central. A detour will be in place until construction completion (see map over the page)

Standard construction hours

Standard construction hours are 6:30am to 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.



Out of hours works

Some activities will be completed out of normal construction hours. Timing of these works are detailed in project updates - follow steps to register.



24 hours

Tunnelling and tunnelling support activities are undertaken 24 hours a day.

Albert Street controlled blasting update

As part of excavation of the tunnel access adits, controlled blasting activities will be undertaken within the acoustic shed (Lot 2) at various times **throughout November 2020**.

Blasting will be carried out between 7:30am and 4:30pm, Monday to Saturday, excluding public holidays.
