## Trackside signalling work in August

Hitachi Rail is continuing construction work along the Shorncliffe Line to deliver Brisbane's new railway signalling system as part of the Cross River Rail Project.

### Details of work

During **August** construction work will continue in the rail corridor at sites from **Northgate to Shorncliffe stations**.

The majority of works will occur between **6:00am to 6:00pm, Monday to Friday**. Activities will include excavation, trenching, concreting, cabling works, and installing signalling equipment and equipment housing.

To facilitate works, some **changes to station car parks will be necessary**, including at Sandgate and Deagon. Please see local signage for details.

To ensure the safety of workers and the community, some activities will be **undertaken during track closures (where buses will replace trains) outside of normal construction hours**, weather permitting:

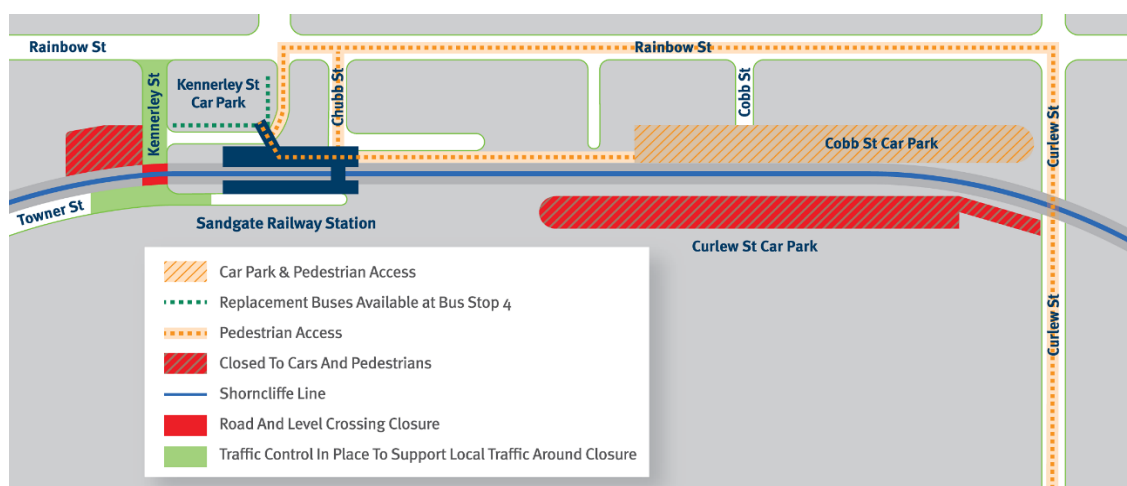

There will also be changes to traffic conditions with scheduled closures and traffic control including:

Location	Date and details
Kennerley Street, Sandgate	11pm Friday 30 July – 5am Monday 2 August Full road closure. Detours in place via Adams Street, Deagon.
Curlew Street, Sandgate	Day works – Tuesday 3 August – Thursday 5 August Hold and release traffic control. Parts of the Cobb Street car park will also be closed.
Palm Avenue, Sandgate	11pm Friday 6 August – 5am Monday 9 August Full road closure. Detours in place via Pier Avenue, Sunday Street, Allpass Parade and Sinbad Street
Adams and Smith streets, Deagon	11pm Friday 13 August – 5am Monday 16 August Full road closure. Detours in place via Kennerley Street, Sandgate.

### What to expect if you live alongside the rail corridor

Residents along the rail corridor may see and hear dust and noise associated with the use of machinery and equipment (including excavators, skid steer loaders, concrete trucks and pumps, and vacuum trucks), and mobile lighting towers in work areas during night works.

To minimise impacts: environmental controls will manage noise and dust (including noise minimisation practices after hours), lighting towers will be directed away from residential properties, where practical.
