Construction update Fairfield station

During July 2021, cable service route installation works continued at Fairfield station. During August 2021, UNITY Alliance will continue construction activities at Fairfield station for construction of the Cross River Rail project.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during August 2021, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Continue cable service route installation works within the rail corridor using a small excavator, bobcat, small tip truck, delivery vehicles and light vehicles
- Continue to access the rail corridor via Broadmere Street, Annerley
- Commence track lowering preparation works within the rail corridor
- General station and track investigations including survey and locating services.

Out of hours work

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours but are timed to take place within planned weekend track closures, as outlined below:

Signage will be in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists around works areas. Please observe the directions of traffic control while passing through the area. We appreciate your patience during construction and will continue to update you as work progresses.

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Single lane closures on Ensign Avenue (14-15 August) and single lane closures on Mildmay Street and Equity Street (30 August-6 September) for construction access to the rail corridor. Access will be maintained for pedestrians and motorists. Please observe signage and direction of traffic control

- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators with hydraulic hammers, vacuum trucks, concrete pump trucks, concrete trucks, mobile cranes, drilling rig, saws, small power tools, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Some noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment
- Placement of temporary fencing around construction areas.
