Construction update Yeronga station

During September 2021, UNITY Alliance will temporarily close Cowper Street at Fairfield Road for approximately six months, to enable construction of the new pedestrian overpass over Fairfield Road connecting to the upgraded Yeronga station.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday, during September 2021, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Installation of temporary fencing around the new Fairfield Road pedestrian overpass construction area near Cowper Street. Commence construction with earthworks and piling for foundation works
- Continuing platform retaining wall construction
- Continuing piling on platforms 1 and 2 for platform foundation works, and installation of platform concrete
- Identification and relocation of public utilities (water, sewer, communications and electrical)
- Track and maintenance work between Yeronga and Fairfield stations.

Out of hours work

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours, as outlined below:

Location	Date and hours of work	Type of work
Fairfield Road, Yeronga	Between 7:00pm and 5:00am intermittently during September 2021	 Closure of Cowper Street by installing barriers and traffic control measures across the road. This will enable construction of the new pedestrian overpass Intermittent southbound lane closures to undertake installation of bored piles in the rail corridor adjacent to Fairfield Road Earthwork and concrete works adjacent to Fairfield Road Installation of temporary fencing.

Please note that Yeronga station is now closed as part of an accessibility rebuild. To support customers during the closure, StationLink route 109 now running between Moorooka and Boggo Road stations.

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Temporary closure of Cowper Street at Fairfield Road until early 2022 (refer to map above). Access to Cowper Street will be maintained via Shottery Street. Traffic control and local road diversions will be in place. Please observe signage and traffic control to safely navigate through the area.
- Intermittent traffic changes on Fairfield Road between Kadumba Street and Yeronga Street (refer to map above). Fairfield Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction. During these intermittent changes the StationLink bus stops on Fairfield Road near Yeronga station will impacted. Please observe signage and traffic control to safely navigate through the area.
- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators with hydraulic hammers, frontend loaders, mobile
 cranes, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile
 lighting towers to light work areas at night
