Construction update

In early September, an intensive period of work was completed within the rail corridor allowing construction of the Southern Tunnel Portal to continue. We thank you for your patience during this time.

A major project milestone was also achieved in September with the arrival of two roadheaders that excavated a total distance of 900 metres underground from the new Woolloongabba station to the new Boggo Road station.

Southern Tunnel Portal construction activities



In October, major rail corridor works will continue and will include:

- Building the foundations of the tunnel portal entrance near Railway Terrace including ongoing piling and related activities
- Ongoing 24-hour micro-tunnelling within the shaft at Dutton Street and travelling underneath Railway Terrace
- Continuing to build the tunnel portal structure and new above ground train lines within the Kent Street worksite
- Rail corridor works between Dutton Park, Park Road and Buranda stations
- Construction of a new retaining wall adjacent to Dutton Park station.

Boggo Road station construction activities



Works will continue to build the new Boggo Road station and cavern during October. These works will include:

- Continuing construction of the permanent station structure including the deepest section of the station
- Installing drainage within the base of the structure
- Operating both tower cranes to facilitate activities within the station box.

Tunnel cavern works are expected to be completed in late 2021.

Over the coming months, works will be undertaken to finalise the permanent structure, waterproofing and drainage within the cavern.

Upcoming rail corridor works

Queensland rail corridor works between Park Road and Buranda stations are scheduled to occurred between Saturday 2 and Monday 4 October 2021. For more information on these works, please visit **queenslandrail.com.au**.

Rail corridor works between Dutton Park, Park Road and Buranda stations are scheduled from **Friday 9 October to Monday 11 October 2021.**

These works are scheduled during the day and at night and may generate medium to high levels of noise at times.

Major rail corridor works near Railway Terrace will continue throughout October.

During construction, you may notice:

- Works planned during the day and at night that may generate increased levels of noise, at times
- · General construction activity including the use of heavy machinery, hand tools and the presence of workers
- Vehicles and machinery accessing Boggo Road and Southern Tunnel Portal work sites as well as the rail corridor
- An increase in noise, vibration and dust
- Construction impact mitigation activities such as street sweepers and water carts.

Construction hours



Standard construction hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm. Monday to Saturday.



Some activities will be completed out of normal construction hours between 6.30pm to 6.30am, due to traffic permits, safety requirements and construction methodology.



Tunnelling and rail corridor works are undertaken 24 hours a day.

Cross River Rail proposes that in the event a COVID19 public health direction is announced for the Brisbane local government area or Brisbane central business district, the morning and afternoon peak haulage restrictions be relaxed at the Boggo Road worksite.
