Construction update Clapham Yard

In September 2021, UNITY Alliance continued demolition works within Clapham Yard. During October 2021, earthworks on the site will continue for construction of the Cross River Rail project. These works are in preparation for a new train stabling facility at Clapham Yard.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during October 2021, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Commencement of the permanent drainage works
- Commencement of retaining wall construction adjacent to Fairfield Road
- Continuing earthworks to level construction areas, ground surface treatment works and excavation
- Capping redundant services and removal of buried structures including stormwater drainage, sewer lines, water lines and footings
- Importing materials, including placement and compaction of gravel for the stabling yard
- Closure of Chale Street to non-construction related traffic, including heavy and long vehicle parking
- Temporary footpath closure on the eastern side of Fairfield Road to enable retaining wall and embankment works. Pedestrian access is via the western side of Fairfield Road between Palomar Road and Sherwood Road
- Track and maintenance work within the rail corridor.

Out of hours work

These activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours as outlined below, weather and construction conditions permitting:

Fairfield Road, Yeerongpilly	Intermittently Monday-Saturday 7:00pm to 5:00am during October 2021	 Removal of billboard near Sherwood Road. For the safety of motorists some of these works must occur at night under temporary single lane closures on Fairfield Road southbound around work areas
		 Public utility service investigations (water and sewer) where traffic control is required, or restrictions have been imposed by service providers
		 Drainage installation works adjacent to Fairfield Road.
Fairfield Road, Yeerongpilly	Intermittently Monday-Saturday 4:30am to 6:30am during October 2021	Delivery of materials to site including concrete, gravels and building supplies.

Signage will be in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists around works areas. Please observe the directions of traffic control while passing through the area.



What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Temporary traffic changes on Fairfield Road, Yeerongpilly to assist with demolition of billboard, removal of material from site, and drainage works
- Closure of Chale Street to all non-construction traffic
- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators, graders, rollers, water carts, front end loaders, mobile cranes, vacuum excavation trucks, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light the work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Some noise, vibration and dust associated with heavy machinery and equipment.
