Construction update Fairfield station

In October 2021, UNITY Alliance carried out track lowering preparation works at Fairfield station including cable and service relocation works. During November 2021, UNITY Alliance will continue track lowering preparation works.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during November 2021, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Continue track lowering preparation works within the rail corridor
- Installing overhead electrical line foundations and masts
- General station and track investigations including survey and locating services.

Out of hours work

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours but are timed to take place within a number of planned track closures, as outlined below:

Fairfield station, Equity Street and Mildmay Street / Ashby Street	Intermittently between 2:00am Saturday 27 and 2:00am Monday 29 November 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Installing overhead electrical line masts using cranes for lifting activities from within the rail corridor, with access to the rail corridor from Mildmay Street and Equity Street performed under a single lane closure with traffic control to assist motorists Station platform cable service route relocation works • Mildmay Street / Ashby Street guardrail removal to prepare for track lowering works, performed under a single lane closure with traffic control to assist motorists. Installation of water-filled barriers. • Track work and maintenance.

Signage will be in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists around works areas. Please observe the directions of traffic control while passing through the area.

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Single lane two-way traffic arrangement in place on Mildmay Street / Ashby Street Saturday 27 and Sunday 28 November 2021 (refer to map)
- Single lane two-way traffic arrangement in place on Equity Street Saturday 27 and Sunday 28 November 2021 (refer to map)
- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators with hydraulic hammers, loaders, vacuum trucks, concrete pump trucks, concrete trucks, mobile cranes, drilling rig, saws, small power tools, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Increased noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment
- Placement of temporary fencing around construction areas.

We appreciate your patience during construction and will continue to update you as work progresses.
