## Construction update

Thank you for your patience as we completed important rail corridor works over the holiday period. We appreciate your ongoing understanding and can confirm that a new section of rail track was completed as planned and is now operational.

New work areas have opened up for Southern Tunnel Portal and Boggo Road station, and cavern construction continues.

### Boggo Road station construction

Construction of the Boggo Road tunnel cavern is now complete, a key milestone for the Boggo Road station. The next stage of construction will involve building the future station platforms inside the cavern.

Boggo Road station construction will continue 24 hours, Monday to Friday and during the day on Saturday. This includes:

- Steel work and concreting to build the permanent station structure
- Crane and machinery deliveries and operation to facilitate activities within the station box.

### Southern Tunnel Portal construction

As mentioned above, a new train track has been constructed on the eastern side of the Southern Tunnel Portal worksite, allowing space for a new work area in the middle of the rail corridor.

Works to build the foundation of the tunnel portal have now started in this area with piling and related activities. See the map and timeline overleaf for more detail.

Micro-tunnelling under Railway Terrace and Kent Street is now complete and works to connect new and existing services continues. Work at Shafts 1 and 3B as per the map and timeline overleaf will continue.

Additional construction activities for the Southern Tunnel Portal in February include:

- Steel work, concreting and excavation to build the tunnel portal within Kent Street and Boggo Road south worksites
- Piling and related activities during the day and at night.

### Upcoming weekend rail corridor works



Weekend rail corridor works are scheduled throughout 2022 between Dutton Park, Park Road and Buranda stations. Advanced notification of works will be provided each month.

In February, weekend works are planned on **Saturday 12 and Sunday 13**, and **Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 February 2022**. Over these weekends existing rail bridge piers adjacent to Railway Terrace will be strengthened enabling construction of the tunnel portal to continue underneath.

### During construction, you may notice:

- Works during the day and at night that may generate increased levels of noise, at times
- General construction activity including use of heavy machinery, hand tools and the presence of workers
- 24 hour work hours for Boggo Road station and cavern, and Southern Tunnel Portal
- Vehicles and machinery accessing Boggo Road and Southern Tunnel Portal work sites as well as the rail corridor
- An increase in noise, vibration and dust
- Construction impact mitigation activities such as street sweepers and water carts.

## Southern Tunnel Portal works timeline



### Scope of key works

**1** Piling has commenced in the new work area and will occur during the day and at night. Works are expected to take approximately eight weeks to complete.


**2** Works to strengthen the rail bridge are scheduled during weekend rail corridor works under the freight train line.

**3** The train line that runs nearest to Railway Terrace (known as the dual gauge), which was temporary closed in August 2021, will be reinstated and operational in March 2022.

**Between late January and early March, you may notice an increase in construction activity and construction vehicle movements in this area, 24 hours/7 days.** This will include concrete deliveries via Rawnsley Street, Railway Terrace and Dutton Street.

**4** Piling in Boggo Road south worksite, adjacent to the Boggo Road station will recommence in March 2022 for approximately two weeks.

**5** Early works commence for the pedestrian and cycling bridge in March. Please see attached flyer for information on the bridge. Additional information regarding construction will be provided in mid-2022.
