Trackside signalling work

Construction work is well advanced along the Shorncliffe Line to deliver Brisbane's new railway signalling system as part of the Cross River Rail Project.

Details of work

During February, construction work will continue in the rail corridor at sites between Northgate and Shorncliffe stations.

Activities along the rail corridor will include drilling, excavation, concreting, cable, fence and equipment housing installation, and installing and modifying on-track and trackside signalling equipment.

Work will also continue on the radio mast near Sandgate station, with radio mast foundation works scheduled for Nudgee and North Boondall.

The majority of works will occur between 6.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday.

To facilitate works, there will be changes to car parks at Sandgate, Deagon and Nudgee. See table overleaf and local signage for more details.

Some activities will be undertaken outside normal construction hours, as per the table below (weather and construction conditions permitting).

















Shorncliffe line work areas



What to expect if you live alongside the rail corridor

Residents along the rail corridor may see and hear dust and noise associated with the use of machinery and equipment, and mobile lighting towers in work areas during night works.

To minimise impacts environmental controls will manage noise and dust (including noise minimisation practices after hours), and lighting towers will be directed away from residential properties, wherever practical.

Date and hours	Location	Car park changes
Ongoing	North Boondall	The Northern end of the Peacock Street car park is currently being used for material storage.
From 11.00pm Monday 7 to 6.00pm Tuesday 8 February.	Sandgate	A section of the Curlew Street car park (station end) at Sandgate will be closed to vehicles. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
From 6.00am Monday 14 to 6.00pm Friday 18 February	Nudgee	A section of the Nudgee station car park (North-eastern end) will be temporarily closed from Monday 14 February until Friday 18 February.
From 6.00am Saturday 19 to 5.00am Monday 21 February	Sandgate	The Kennerley Street car park (near Towner Street) will be closed and there will be no access to bike lockers. The Cobb Street car park will be partially closed to vehicles (station end). Pedestrians to follow guidance.
From 6.00am Saturday 19 to 5.00pm Sunday 20 February and then from 6.00am Monday 21 February to 5.00pm Friday 18 March	Deagon	Sections of the car park will be closed. Access to the car park will be via Doris Street.
