Trackside signalling work

Construction work is nearing completion along the Shorncliffe Line to deliver Brisbane's new railway signalling system as part of the Cross River Rail Project.

Details of work

During March, construction work will continue in the rail corridor at sites between Northgate and Shorncliffe stations.

Over the next few months, the final stage of civil works will be completed in preparation for testing the new signalling system.

Activities along the rail corridor will include site surveying, equipment testing, electrical works, installation of on-track signalling equipment, cable hauling and the installation of equipment housing.

Installation of the radio masts and antennas at North Boondall and Nudgee will continue, with construction at Northgate expected to commence this month. The majority of works will occur between 6.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday.

This month, you may also see and hear Queensland Rail crews completing repair works after the recent severe weather event.

What to expect

To facilitate works, there will be changes to car parks at Kennerley Street (near Towner Street), Sandgate and at Deagon station. The northern end of North Boondall car park will continue to be closed and used for material storage and crew amenities until mid-2022.

The northern external overpass at Boondall station will also continue to be closed between 6.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday until 11 March with pedestrians directed to use the alternate crossing. Please see local signage for details.

Some activities will be undertaken outside normal construction hours, as per the table below (weather and construction conditions permitting). Work patterns may also vary this month due to recent and expected ongoing inclement weather.






What to expect if you live alongside the rail corridor

Residents along the rail corridor may see and hear dust and noise associated with the use of machinery and equipment, and mobile lighting towers in work areas during night works. To minimise impacts environmental controls will manage noise and dust, and lighting towers will be directed away from residential properties, wherever practical.


