Construction update Salisbury station

During April 2023, UNITY Alliance will be undertaking construction activities in your local area as part of the Cross River Rail project.

Between **Good Friday 7 and Thursday 27 April 2023**, there will be track closures and changes to transport services due to Cross River Rail works across the Queensland Rail network. During this time there will be changes to train operations at Salisbury station. Customers are encouraged to plan their journey in advance by downloading the MyTranslink app, visit translink.com.au or call 13 12 30.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during April 2023, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Service trenching and cable route installation.

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours over the Easter long weekend, weather and construction conditions permitting:

Salisbury station	Between 6:30am and 6:30pm daily from Friday 7 to Tuesday 11 April 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Installation of overhead electrical line mast footings• Excavation (including the use of vacuum trucks) and removal of material for service location works• Cable service relocation works including trenching and installation• Installation of under track crossings (conduits) for services (e.g., electrical).

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- A single lane closure on Fairlie Terrace and Dollis Street to access the rail corridor (please see map overleaf). Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists around work areas
- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators (with rock breaker), bobcat, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, concrete pump trucks, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Increased levels of noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment
- Placement of temporary fencing around construction areas.

Cross River Rail won't just transform Brisbane, it will transform the way we travel across South East Queensland.
