Normanby rail corridor construction update

As outlined in the April and May 2023 Northern Portal construction update, Unity Alliance have remobilised to the northern portal worksite and CBGU-JV are in the final stages of demobilising.

During June 2023, UNITY Alliance will remove the timber bridge section of the footbridge over the Normanby Rail corridor. Since its closure in October 2022 for safety reviews, subsequent reviews of Cross River Rail construction and design have been undertaken. It has been determined that the bridge could not safely accommodate future rail operations and therefore will be demolished.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during June and July 2023, weather and construction conditions permitting:


- Removal of a section of the Queensland Rail timber pedestrian bridge over the weekend of Saturday 24 and Monday 26 June 2023. Once the section of bridge is removed, pedestrians and cyclists will need to continue to use alternative access routes
- · Removal of redundant structures within the rail corridor
- Drainage construction and rail service installation around the Northern Portal
- Earthworks and pavement construction around Bowen Bridge Road and the Northern Portal
- Installation of overhead electrical structures, mast foundations, signalling equipment, cable routes and pits within the rail corridor
- Surveying and investigating underground services, such as water, electricity and gas
- · Track work and maintenance.

Out of hours work

Additional activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours, as outlined below:

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- For the safety of pedestrians and cyclists, the Victoria Park shared user path will be temporarily closed from 5:00am Saturday 24 until 5:00am Monday 26 June 2023, while a section of the pedestrian bridge is removed (subject to construction planning and permit approvals) During the temporary closure of the Victoria Park shared user path during bridge removal works, traffic management will be in place and pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured via Gregory Terrace and College Road.
- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators with hydraulic hammers, mobile cranes, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light the work areas at night.
