Roma Street station Subway and Bus Platform Upgrades

From mid-June, parts of the Roma Street station subway will be sectioned off to facilitate demolition works for the Roma Street station Subway and Bus Platform upgrade project.

To minimise impacts on customers demolition works within the subway will be undertaken in a staged approach. Once all demolition works are complete, subway fit out activities will commence.

Works are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Sunday, construction conditions permitting. When required, out of hours works will be undertaken between 11pm and 5am Monday to Sunday.

Details of work

Station subway

From **mid-June to mid-July 2023**, the following activities will be undertaken within the station subway between platforms 7 and 10:

- installation of floor to ceiling hoarding around work areas
- removal of station subway floor tiles with the use of jackhammers and floor grinders
- installation of temporary floor protection.

The stairs to platform 8 and 9 on the eastern side will be closed for the duration of this stage. Access to platform 8 and 9 will be maintained for customers via the lift and stairs on the western side of the subway.

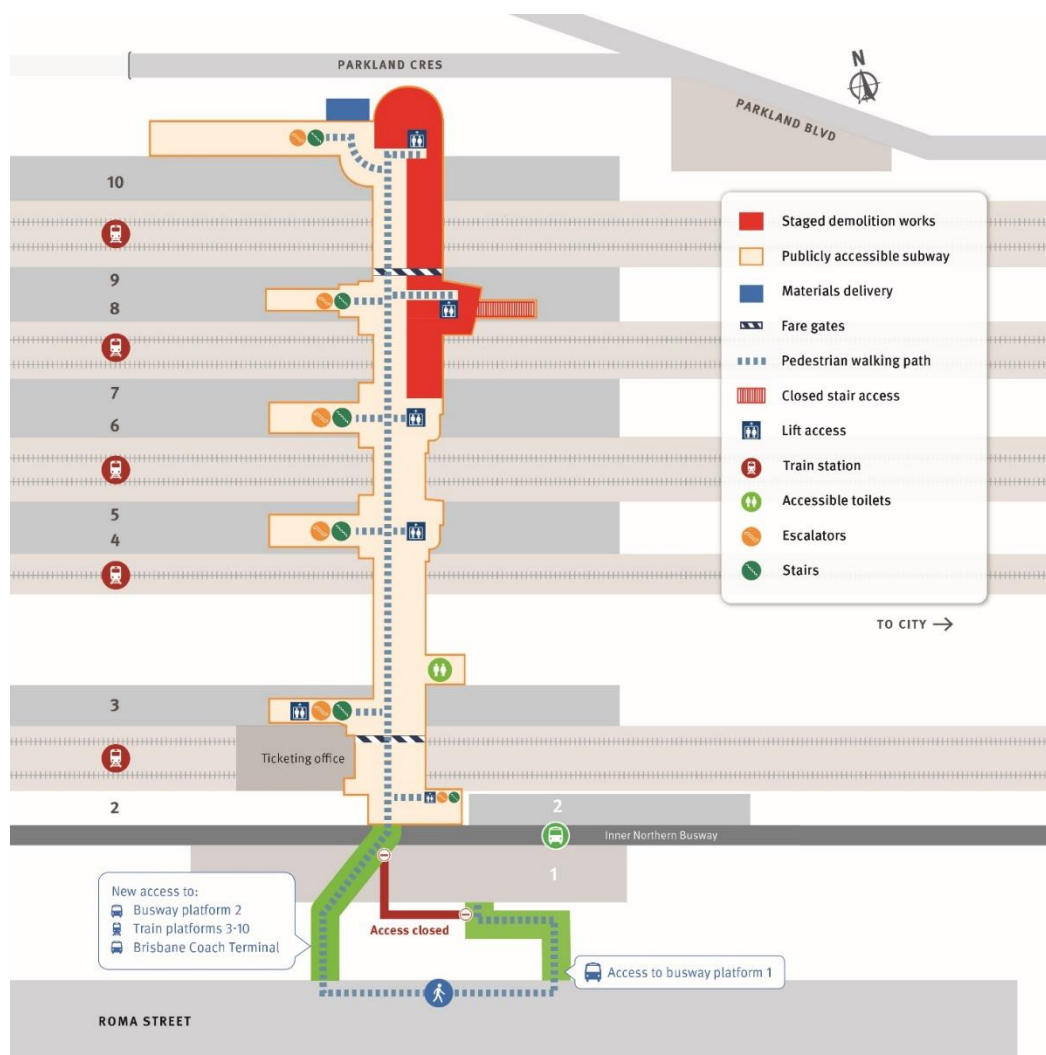

Site establishment and platform 2

From **mid-June** a work area will be established on Parkland Boulevard to facilitate out of hours materials delivery and waste removal for the duration of the project. This work will include:

- removal of the garden bed off Parkland Boulevard. The garden bed will be reinstated at the end of project works
- removal of the garden bed within the subway using a vacuum truck out of hours
- installation of temporary worksite hoarding on Parkland Boulevard
- small concrete pour involving concrete trucks and pumps parked on Parkland Boulevard to establish the work area in the subway
- ongoing out of hours delivery and removal of site materials.

Site establishment activities on platform 3 and upgrade works on busway platform 2, are continuing. For more information on these works scan the QR code below.



What to expect

During these works, access to platforms, lifts and the subway will be maintained. There will be temporary and intermittent changes to customer access during the works. Customers and the local community may notice an increase in construction activities and workforce which may generate increased levels of noise, dust and vibration. Mitigation measures will be in place, where possible, to reduce impacts.

There will be intermittent use of concrete saws, jackhammers, grinders, small power tools, minor vibrating equipment, generators, concrete pumps, vacuum trucks and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night.

Materials and machinery for subway works will be delivered and removed from site between 11pm and 5am via Parkland Boulevard. Vehicle access through Parkland Boulevard will be maintained under the direction of traffic control.

We appreciate your patience during construction and will continue to update you as work progresses.
