Construction update Yeronga station

In May and June 2023, reinstatement of the Dublin Stret noise barrier, fencing and electrical works were undertaken at Yeronga station. During July and August, minor finishing works at Yeronga station will continue.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during July and August 2023, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Continue finishing works including fencing, minor sealing and grouting of platforms and block walls, painting, and testing services (e.g., electrical)
- Continue station cleaning including the use of high-pressure water hose and sealing (coating) station platforms
- Continue minor landscaping near the Lake Street entry and corner of Fairfield Road / Cowper and reinstatement of disturbed areas.

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours, weather and construction conditions permitting:

Fairfield Road and Cowper Street	Between 8:00pm and 5:00am intermittently during July-August 2023	 Excavation, concreting, concrete patching and sealing works Fairfield Road outbound emergency egress gate installation.
Yeronga station	Between 12:00am Saturday 1 and 3:00am Monday 3 July 2023	Station building and platform rectification works (e.g., sealing works)
	Between 2:00am Saturday 15 and 3:00am Monday 17 July 2023	Reinstating disturbed areas in the rail corridor including the use of excavators.

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Intermittent single lane closures on Fairfield Road between Kadumba Street and Yeronga Street
- Intermittent temporary closures on Lake Street between Killarney Street and Christensen Street
- Light vehicles, trucks, excavators with hydraulic hammers, front end loaders, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, concrete pump trucks, high-pressure water cleaners, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
