Construction update Fairfield station

In June 2023, UNITY Alliance installed footings for the old Fairfield station waiting shelter on platform 1 (refer to map). During July 2023, works will continue on platform 3, station building fit out and streetscaping on Equity Street and Mildmay Street.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during July 2023, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Continue service installation for station and street lighting
- Continue fit out of the station overpass, stairs, lifts, station buildings and canopies
- Continue station fencing installation and footing installation for the old Fairfield station waiting shelter
- · Removing concrete and material using concrete saws, an excavator (with rock breaker) and trucks
- Continue streetscaping including footpaths, installing light poles and signs, landscaping, installing formwork and concreting
 for new kerbing, line marking, road profiling and asphalting on Mildmay Street and Equity Street.

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours, as outlined below:

		Removal of a tree on Equity Street near the commuter car park (day shift only). A mature native species will be replanted as part of the final station landscaping works
		Installation of end of platform asphalt pathways.
	Between 2:00am Saturday 15 and 3:00am Monday 17 July 2023	Station platform canopies and buildings fit out works
		Streetscaping including concreting and landscaping
		Station overpass sealing, lift and stair fit out works. Please note that the station overpass will be temporarily closed during this activity.

What to expect

During these works you will notice intermittent disruptions such as:

- Temporary closure of the Fairfield station pedestrian overpass between 6:30am Saturday 1 and 6:30pm Sunday 2, and
 6:30am Saturday 15 and 6:30pm Sunday 16 July 2023 during a scheduled rail closure. Pedestrians are advised to use the Cronin Street overpass during this time
- Intermittent closures of Mildmay Street / Ashby Street between Lanyard Street and Southall Street, and Equity Street between Cronin Street and Clive Street. Access will be maintained to properties located within the road closure extents under traffic control guidance
- Trucks, frontend loaders, excavators with rock breakers, vacuum trucks, mobile cranes, concrete trucks, concrete pump trucks, concrete saws, grinders, small power tools, minor vibrating equipment, generators, and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
