Construction update Yeerongpilly station

In preparation for major construction to start in September, during August, temporary traffic changes will be implemented including the closure the northern Wilkie Street commuter car park for construction laydown and offices.

Major construction to upgrade Yeerongpilly station is planned to start in September 2023 and detailed information will be provided before work commences.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during August 2023, weather and construction conditions permitting (refer to map for more details):

- Continuing identification and location of inground services
- Temporary relocation of the existing bus stops on Wilkie Street to Green Street. This requires construction of a footpath and new bus stop on Green Street. The existing bus stops will continue to operate until the new stop on Green Street is open on 21 August 2023. - Closure of the northern Wilkie Street commuter car park from Monday 21 August to enable establishment of temporary site office facilities
- Removal of on-street parking on Wilkie Street and changes to line marking to facilitate construction vehicle movements
- Delivery of construction materials and equipment near the Wilkie Street commuter car park between Stamford Street and Green Street
- Minor vegetation removal.

Out of hours work

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours, weather and construction conditions permitting as outlined below:

Yeerongpilly Station and Wilkie Street	Nightly between 6:30pm and 6:30am from Monday 21 to Friday 25 August 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Installation of concrete traffic barriers, line marking and signage on Wilkie Street (refer to map), including the use of trucks, mobile cranes, generators and lighting towers• Location of inground services including the use of vacuum trucks.

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Construction access into the rail corridor will be via the Queensland Rail gates on Wilkie Street, Yeerongpilly
- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators, trucks, vacuum truck, concrete trucks, loaders, power tools, generators, and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Some noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment.
