Hope Island station – Preliminary works

Cross River Rail is transforming the way we travel across all of South East Queensland. The Cross River Rail Delivery Authority is continuing with planning and delivery of three new rail stations on the Gold Coast Line to help connect South East Queensland's growing population. Stations are being planned for Pimpama, Hope Island and Merrimac.

Details of works

From Monday 14 August 2023, early works are scheduled to commence in Mangrove Jack Park and along Hope Island Road, Helensvale, in preparation for the new Hope Island station. Works will include:

- Preparing for overhead line equipment relocation to be carried out in late 2023
- This includes the use of elevated work platforms and drilling works on the western rail viaduct using hand held tools.

These preliminary works will continue for approximately 2 weeks, weather and site conditions permitting.

What to expect

Works will be undertaken using elevated work platforms at the western extent of the rail corridor, in Mangrove Jack Park.

Residents will see an increase of workers in the area. These works may result in increased levels of noise from the use of equipment and machinery. For further details on the location of these works please see the map overleaf.

Works will be undertaken between 7.00am until 5.00pm Monday to Friday, and 8.00am to 1.00pm Saturday.
