Signalling work and system testing

Construction work is nearing completion and system testing is continuing along the Shorncliffe Line to deliver Brisbane's new railway signalling system as part of the Cross River Rail Project.

Details of work

During August, construction work will continue in the rail corridor at sites between Northgate and Shorncliffe stations. System testing will also be carried out.

Construction activities along the rail corridor will include equipment testing, modifications to on-track and trackside equipment, installation of equipment huts, and minor civil works including concreting.

To safely complete works, car park changes will be required at Curlew Street and Cobb Street car parks, Sandgate. Please see local signage for details.

Day works during August are scheduled between Monday and Friday from 6:00am until 6:00pm.

Some activities will be undertaken outside normal construction hours, as per the table below (weather and construction conditions permitting).

Between 6:00am and 10:00pm each day on Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 August.	Between Northgate and Shorncliffe stations	 Signalling testing. No passenger trains will be operational. Alternative transport options will be available. Plan your journey by downloading the MyTransLink app, visit translink.com.au, or call 13 12 30.

Queensland Rail will be undertaking works at Deagon station from 1 August to 7 August. Pedestrian detours will be in place in Albury Street during these works.
