Construction update Fairfield station

In September 2023, UNITY Alliance continued car park construction on Equity Street, and streetscaping works around the station precinct. During October 2023, construction works will be nearing completion of major construction for works on platform 3, building works, canopy installation and fit out of station lifts.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during October 2023, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Continue service installation for station and street lighting
- Continue fit out of the station overpass, stairs, lifts, station buildings and canopies
- Continue concrete ramp and stair access installation for the old Fairfield station waiting shelter
- Water service connection cutover involving a short period of service disruption to some properties (up to 30 minutes). Please note that affected properties will be advised greater than 48 hours prior to works
- Continue streetscaping including footpaths, installing light poles, signs and landscaping
- Installing formwork and concreting for new kerbing, line marking, road profiling and asphaltting on Mildmay Street and Equity Street.

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours, as outlined below:

	Between 2:00am Saturday 30 September and 6:00am Friday 6 October 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Service installation for station platforms, buildings, lifts and street lighting • High pressure water cleaning on station platforms including the use of generators for cleaning equipment • Streetscaping and landscaping around station entries • Concreting for station footpaths and kerbing.

What to expect

During these works you will notice intermittent disruptions such as:

- Intermittent closures of Mildmay Street / Ashby Street between Lanyard Street and Southall Street, and closures Equity Street between Cronin Street and Clive Street. Access will be maintained to properties located within the road closure extents under traffic control guidance
- Trucks, frontend loaders, excavators with rock breakers, vacuum trucks, mobile cranes, concrete trucks, concrete pump trucks, concrete saws, grinders, small power tools, minor vibrating equipment, generators, and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Increased noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment.
