Boggo Road and Southern Area - construction update

Throughout October and November, work on the Boggo Road pedestrian and cycle bridge will continue with the delivery and installation of the eastern and western bridge approaches. At the new Boggo Road station, work continues with installation of steel, concrete and precast concrete segments as construction reaches ground level.

Pedestrian and cycle bridge update

Out of hours work will continue to construct the connecting ramps, deliver and install posts and screens and receive deliveries.

Some local short-term road changes may be in place during this work. Please follow direction of traffic control officers and signage.

More information will be distributed prior to any changes.

Boggo Road station update

Throughout October and November 2023, construction of the Boggo Road station continues as the structure reaches ground level. Mechanical and electrical fit-out is ongoing at the southern end of the Boggo Road station.

Southern Portal update

Permanent lining of the tunnel portal is nearing completion with mechanical and electrical (M&E) and track fit out works commencing over the coming months.

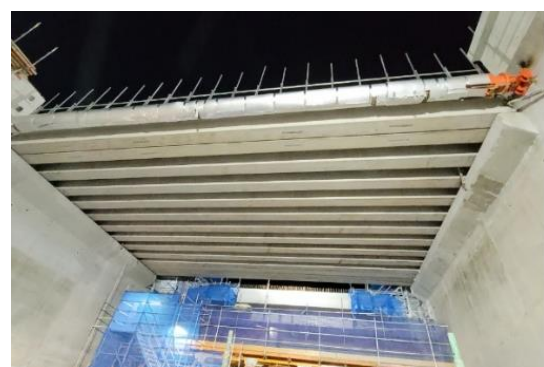


Image: B1 Deck unit installed in the central zone of Boggo Road station

Day and night work	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Concrete pours scheduled overnight or in the early hours of the morning• Use of cranes and other large machinery• Delivery and installation of precast concrete segments during the day and at night• Ongoing M&E fit out work• Excavation and construction of retaining wall construction adjacent to busway• Delivery of equipment and materials via Boggo Road, Joe Baker Street and Peter Doherty Street.

Pedestrian and cycle bridge construction

Peter Doherty to Kent Street

Ongoing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pedestrian and cycling bridge deck work
Day and night work	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Out-of-hours concrete pours• Delivery and installation of steel girder segments and other materials at night• Delivery of equipment and materials via Boggo Road, Joe Baker Street and Peter Doherty Street in the west plus Kent Street and PA Hospital access road in the east• Intermittent road and shared user path closures.
Ongoing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Survey prism maintenance and inspection in rail corridor
Day and night work	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Signalling and telecommunications relocation in rail corridor.

Construction hours:

- Boggo Road station construction hours are 24 hours Monday to Friday and 6.30am to 6.30pm on Saturdays unless advised.
- Southern Tunnel Portal and pedestrian and cycle bridge construction hours are 24 hours, seven days a week. This includes work during weekend rail corridor closures.

What to expect during construction:

- Increased levels of noise, dust and vibration
- Construction vehicles travelling to and from the worksite via Boggo Road, Joe Baker Street and Peter Doherty Street, Rawnsley Street, Railway Terrace, Dutton Street and Kent Street
- Delivery of materials and equipment to the worksite at night
- Extended concrete pours scheduled to start early in the morning
- Temporary closures of local streets including Kent, Joe Baker and Peter Doherty streets
- Potential short-term disruption to utility services. Additional notification will be provided if impacts are expected.
