Signalling work and system testing

Construction work is nearing completion and system testing is continuing along the Shorncliffe line to deliver Brisbane's new railway signalling system as part of Cross River Rail.

Details of work

During November, construction work will continue in the rail corridor at sites between Northgate and Shorncliffe stations and system testing will be carried out.

From Monday 13 to Thursday 23 November, buses will replace trains between Northgate and Shorncliffe to allow crews to test the new world-class European Train Control System (ETCS). This critical testing will see the system validated against local and international standards.

Timetabled railbuses will replace affected trains during the track closure. Express railbuses will also be available between Northgate and Sandgate stations on weekdays. All services will return to a regular timetable from first service on Friday 24 November.

Construction activities along the rail corridor will include modifications to on-track equipment, concreting, and fencing. To complete works, car park changes will be required along Aberdeen Parade at North Boondall. Please see local signage for details.

Day works during November are scheduled between Monday and Friday from 6:00am until 6:00pm.

Some activities will be undertaken outside normal construction hours, as per the table below (weather and construction conditions permitting).

Thank you for your patience as we work to deliver the vital infrastructure that will transform our rail network.

Between 6.00am Monday 13 to 2.00am Friday 24 November. Trains will resume first service Friday 24 November.	Bindha to Shorncliffe stations	 System testing. Test trains will operate between Bindha and Shorncliffe. Traffic control will be in place at the Nudgee pedestrian crossing (city side of Nudgee station). Horns will sound as per normal operations. No passenger trains will be operational. Alternative transport options will be available.







What to expect if you're a rail customer

Cross River Rail won't just transform Brisbane, it will transform the way we travel across South East Queensland. But building Cross River Rail means changes to travel and transport services during construction.

Buses will replace trains between Northgate and Shorncliffe from Monday 13 to Thursday 23 November.

Temporary changes to the road shoulder area along Aberdeen Parade at North Boondall will be required. See local signage for details.

Customers will be able to plan their specific journey well in advance of travel by using the MyTranslink app, visiting translink.com.au or calling 13 12 30

What to expect if you live alongside the rail corridor

Residents along the rail corridor may see dust and hear noise associated with works (e.g. machinery, light vehicles and work personnel); and mobile lighting towers in work areas during night works.

All staff will be fully briefed about their community responsibilities in relation to minimising noise and disruption after hours.
