Major construction complete - Fairfield station

In October 2023, UNITY Alliance completed major construction at Fairfield station. During November 2023, final rectification and finishing works around the station precinct will be carried out.

Fairfield station accessibility rebuild

As part of the Cross River Rail project, Fairfield station was rebuilt with significant accessibility improvements.

With major construction complete, the following features are now open to customers.

- Station office and public amenities
- Accessible parking
- Customer information screens
- New bicycle shelter
- Lifts.

Final rectification and finishing works will continue at Fairfield station throughout November 2023.

Cross River Rail would like to thank the community for their patience throughout the Fairfield station closure, and their continued patience as the station features progressively came online throughout 2023.

Final rectification and finishing works

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during November 2023, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Continue service installation for station and street lighting
- Minor rectification works including carrying out patching, painting, concrete repairs, steel welding and other related tasks on the pedestrian overpass, station buildings and platforms
- Maintenance of plantings and landscaping.


Out of hours work

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours, as outlined below:

Location	Date and hours of work	Type of work
Fairfield station	Between 6:30pm and 6:30am intermittently during November 2023	 High pressure water cleaning on station platforms including the use of generators for cleaning equipment Station platform sealing and painting works.
	Between 2:00am Saturday 11 and 3:00am Monday 13 November 2023	 Minor rectification works including carrying out patching, painting, concrete repairs, steel welding and other related tasks on the pedestrian overpass, station buildings and platforms
	Between 12:00am Saturday 25 and 3:00am Monday 27 November 2023	 High pressure water cleaning on station platforms including the use of generators for cleaning equipment General streetscaping and landscaping around station entries.

What to expect

During these works you will notice intermittent disruptions such as:

- Intermittent closures of Mildmay Street / Ashby Street between Lanyard Street and Southall Street, and intermittent closures Equity Street between Cronin Street and Clive Street. Access will be maintained to properties located within the road closure extents under traffic control guidance
- Trucks, frontend loaders, excavators with rock breakers, vacuum trucks, mobile cranes, concrete trucks, concrete pump trucks, concrete saws, grinders, high-pressure water units, small power tools, minor vibrating equipment, generators, and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Increased noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment.
