Hope Island station – site establishment

Acciona Georgiou Joint Venture (AGJV) has been awarded the contract to design and build Hope Island station. Early works and site establishment have commenced ahead of major construction starting in 2024.

Details of works

Site establishment

In November, early works and site establishment activities will continue and include:

- Site compound establishment including installing office facilities and temporary fencing along the work area boundary
- Relocating worker facilities to the western boundary of the station site
- Vegetation clearing to accommodate future works
- Relocation of underground utility services
- Earthworks and construction of a piling platform adjacent to the rail corridor
- Ongoing site investigation works including ground surveys and geotechnical assessments

There will be pedestrian changes in Mangrove Jack Park as outlined on the map overpage.

The temporary site compound will remain in place for the duration of construction and will be reinstated as public parkland at the completion of construction activities.

Rail corridor works

From 18 to 20 November 2023, works will be carried out to realign the overhead line wiring from the existing masts to newly installed masts. The existing masts will be decommissioned and removed from the viaduct.

These works will be undertaken within the rail corridor adjacent to Mangrove Jack Park and will include the use of:

- Elevated work platforms, cranes and hand-held tools such as drills
- On-track equipment fitted with safety lighting

To ensure works can be completed safely and efficiently, these activities are planned to occur outside the project's normal working hours when there is reduced rail traffic.


Work hours

Site establishment works will be undertaken between 7am until 5pm Monday to Saturday, weather and construction conditions permitting. The site office will also be accessed before work starts and during out-ofhours works.

Rail corridor works will be carried out from 4am Saturday 18 until 5am Monday 20 November 2023, with high impact activities planned between 7:00am and 5:00pm where possible (weather, site conditions and rail corridor access permitting).











What to expect

- Construction activities may generate increased levels of noise and dust and every effort will be taken to keep noise to a minimum
- Increase in workforce and construction vehicle movements for transport of materials, equipment and machinery
- Use of mobile lighting towers and safety lighting during night works, every effort will be made to position light sources away from properties
- Vegetation clearing, in accordance with all relevant approvals, with fauna spotter/catchers in attendance
- The use of machinery including graders, trucks, compaction equipment, water carts, cranes, vacuum trucks, drill rigs, chainsaws and other hand-held tools.
