## Surveying and early works - Merrimac station

Fulton Hogan has been awarded the contract to design and build Merrimac Station.

Survey and site investigation works are continuing, prior to the commencement of major construction activities.

### Details of work activities

Surveying and early works will continue **from mid-January and throughout February 2024**, prior to the commencement of major construction works.

Activities will include:

- Pre-construction condition inspections of property, utilities and infrastructure, including CCTV of stormwater and sewer lines
- Surveying activities in the parklands
- Inspections of utility and service conditions along Gooding Drive.

These surveying and condition inspections will continue throughout January and February 2024.

Site enabling and mobilisation activities are on track to commence in early 2024, to prepare for major construction.

### What to expect

- Residents may notice an increase in construction workers and vehicles in the area, with teams gaining access to the surrounding areas via Entry Drive, Crelga Court, Willunga Place, Bourton Road, Jura Parade, Jondique Avenue, Gooding Drive, Nisbet Place and Petherbridge Avenue
- To allow us to safely inspect the utility and surface conditions along Gooding Drive, intermittent single lane closures are required in both directions between Jura Parade / Bourton Road and Jondique Avenue / Ghilgai Road in late January 2024
- Traffic management and road signage will be in place to assist and direct motorists in the area during these activities
- Construction activities may generate an increase in noise, but every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum
- The use of light machinery, including hand-held tools
- Residents whose properties are adjacent to the station site may be directly contacted by the project team to discuss specific works activity and/or inspections.

### Work hours

Works will be undertaken between **7:00am and 5:00pm Monday to Saturday**, weather and construction conditions permitting.
