Boggo Road and Southern Area - construction update

The Boggo Road main station building is starting to take shape, with the station building walls beginning to rise above ground level. Below ground, the team is focussing on rail installation, services installation and back of house room fit out.

Pedestrian and cycle bridge update

Over the coming months, out-of-hours work on the bridge will continue, with the installation of the concrete bridge deck, final bridge girder, canopy and privacy screens as well as bridge connecting ramp construction. Pedestrian elevators will be delivered for installation later this year.

Boggo Road station update

Throughout 2024, construction of the Boggo Road station continues with the structure rising above ground level.

Fit-out activities are also progressing down in the station box, with the installation of rail. Services installation and fit-out of the utilities rooms, which will service the future station. Key works are also taking place on the future platform level with 40% of the platform screen doors headers installed.

Southern Portal update

Permanent fit-out works of the tunnel portal will continue with mechanical and electrical (M&E) over the coming months, in preparation for rail and support brackets installation, and delivery of rail and precast track slabs.

Extended rail closures:

There will be track closures across the rail network due to major Cross River Rail works as follows:

- Saturday 24 to Sunday 25 February 2024
- Saturday 2 to Sunday 3 March 2024
- Saturday 16 to Sunday 17 March 2024

Day and night work

- Ongoing steel installation within the station box.
- Concrete pours scheduled overnight or in the early hours of the morning.
- Use of cranes and other large machinery.
- Delivery and installation of precast concrete segments during the day and at night.
- Ongoing mechanical and electrical fit out work.
- Excavation and construction of retaining wall construction adjacent to the busway.
- Delivery of equipment and materials via Boggo Road, Joe Baker Street and Peter Doherty Street
- Track installation and associated delivery of materials

Southern Portal construction

Day and night work

- Use of cranes and other large machinery.
- Finishing works on installed rail infrastructure within the rail corridor.
- · Mechanical and electrical works.
- Delivery of steel rail and precast concrete components for track construction.

Pedestrian and cycle bridge construction

Peter Doherty to Kent Street

Ongoing Day and night work

- Pedestrian and cycling bridge deck work.
- Out-of-hours concrete pours.
- Delivery and installation of materials at night.
- Delivery of equipment and materials via Boggo Road, Joe Baker Street and Peter Doherty Street in the west plus Kent Street and PA Hospital access road in the east.
- Intermittent road and shared user path closures.

General construction hours:

- Boggo Road station construction hours are 24 hours Monday to Friday and 6:30am to 6:30pm on Saturdays unless advised.
- Southern Tunnel Portal and pedestrian and cycle bridge construction is undertaken 24 hours, seven days a week. This includes work during weekend rail corridor closures.

What to expect during construction:

- Increased levels of noise, dust and vibration
- Construction vehicles travelling to and from the worksite via Boggo Road, Joe Baker Street and Peter Doherty Street, Rawnsley Street, Railway Terrace, Dutton Street and Kent Street
- Delivery of materials and equipment to the worksite at night
- Extended concrete pours scheduled to start early in the morning
- Temporary closures of local streets including Kent, Joe Baker and Peter Doherty streets
- Potential short-term disruption to utility services. Additional notification will be provided if impacts are expected.
