

# Works Notice

## Pimpama station construction update

ADCO Constructions is continuing major construction activities along Kosciuszko Circuit and site compound activities on the corner of Mebbin Street and Gainsborough Drive. Further construction work will also continue within the rail corridor.

### Major construction

**Eastern works area (EWA)** – adjacent to Kosciuszko Circuit and Great Sandy Circuit

**Western works area (WWA)** – corner of Mebbin Street and Old Pacific Highway

**Main site compound** – corner of Mebbin Street and Gainsborough Drive.



Throughout February 2024, major construction activities will continue, including:

- Delivery and installation of platform lift shaft and stairs
- Installation of steel frames for platforms, including overpass columns and, and concrete lift shafts
- Structural steel works for platforms, involving ongoing assembly of steel components into frame
- Installation of pits, conduits and under track crossings for services (e.g., communications and electrical)
- Lift well construction works
- Excavation around footings and retaining walls for pedestrian gantry (EWA)
- Concrete pouring and curing for station support infrastructure (EWA) and retaining wall for car park including installing reinforcement, formwork and concrete pours (WWA)
- Earthworks for the car park and station building (WWA)
- Bored piers and bridge column installation
- Excavation around footings and retaining walls for pedestrian gantry
- Delivery and installation of platform lift shafts and stairs (both work areas).

**Rail corridor works** – adjacent to Kosciuszko Circuit, Great Sandy Circuit and Gainsborough Drive.



Rail corridor works are planned to occur outside normal working hours during scheduled track closures, with high impact activities planned between the hours listed below where possible.

Rail corridor works (including nightworks) are scheduled, pending construction and weather conditions, for:

- 6.00am Saturday 10 February to 6.00pm Sunday 11 February 2024
- 6.00am Saturday 17 February to 6.00pm Sunday 18 February 2024
- 6.00am Saturday 24 February to 6.00pm Sunday 25 February 2024.

Rail corridor works in February 2024 will include:



- Excavation and earthworks within the western and eastern side of the rail corridor
- Transport of excavated material from the western and eastern rail corridor to the western works area
- Works associated with structural steel installation including delivery.

### Station access road and drainage

**Station access road construction and drainage works** – within worksite and along the Old Pacific Highway between Pimpama Jacobs Well Rd and Mebbin St.

- Minor concreting repairs
- Fencing and landscaping works
- Minor electrical works
- Line marking on Old Pacific Highway (night works, Monday 29 January).

### Key: Work hours

	<b>Standard construction hours</b> Works will be undertaken between 6.30am until 6.30pm Monday to Saturday. Truck movements and temporary traffic holds will be reduced during peak hour periods to minimise impacts to motorists.		<b>24 hours</b> Rail corridor works are undertaken 24 hours a day, 7 days a week with high impact activities planned between 6.30am to 6.30pm where possible.  Queensland Rail is assisting with enabling works to support the construction of Pimpama station including signalling, overhead line, and telecommunication activities.
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### What to expect

- Construction activities may generate increased levels of noise and dust in the area associated with the works being undertaken.
- Lighting will be required during the rail corridor works.
- Increase in workforce and construction vehicle movements around the station site for transport of materials, equipment, and machinery.
- Ongoing traffic movements with trucks transporting excavated material from the eastern rail corridor on Kosciuszko Circuit to the western works area and main site compound.
- Access to surrounding properties will be maintained during the works with possible delays due to truck movements via traffic control management. Truck movements and temporary traffic holds will be reduced during peak hour periods to minimise impacts to motorists.
