Construction update Salisbury station

During March 2024, UNITY Alliance will continue early works in your local area as part of the Cross River Rail, Salisbury station accessibility upgrade.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during March 2024, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Earthworks, gravel installation and leveling works on Dollis Street. Please note that due to construction works, parking on the eastern side of Dollis Street will no longer be available until completion of the Salisbury station upgrade
- Constructing a stable surface for piling to commence within the rail corridor including excavation and concreting
- Drainage installation works including excavation, steel fixing and concreting
- Service identification using vacuum trucks, and excavation for service installation.

Out of hours work

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours, as outlined below:

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- A single lane closure on Fairlie Terrace and Dollis Street to access the rail corridor (please see map overleaf). Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists around work areas
- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators with jackhammer and rock breaker, bobcat, vacuum trucks, soil sampling drill rig, concrete trucks, concrete pump trucks, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Increased levels of noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment
- Placement of temporary fencing around construction areas.
