# **Update: Woolloongabba station - Main Street traffic and pedestrian changes**

As part of essential utility work required for the new Woolloongabba station, intermittent traffic and pedestrian changes will continue until late 2025 on Main Street between Vulture and Stanley streets.

#### Construction activities

- Installing traffic management including traffic barriers and detour directional signage
- Site investigation to confirm the location of current services
- Excavation and construction of new permanent service lines and new service pits
- Realigning existing service lines
- Footpath reinstatement.

Construction activities are subject to weather, unforeseeable conditions and approvals.

#### What to expect

- Night work involving excavation and construction of new underground service lines and pits
- Use of equipment such as excavators, generators, light vehicles, lighting units, vac trucks, ventilation fans, and hand tools
- You may experience increased noise, lighting, and increase in workforce outside the station site.


### **Traffic and pedestrian impacts**

- From 6:30pm-6:30am Monday to Saturday, intermittent lane closures of the western footpath and the adjacent traffic lane of Main Street between Vulture and Stanley streets.
- Pedestrians will be diverted from the Main Street western footpath via the eastern footpath.
- Traffic control and detours will be in place to support motorists, pedestrians and cyclists, with vehicle access maintained in both directions.
- Access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Footpath and lane closures will not occur during events at the Gabba.
