Green Spine – Pedestrian access update

Work is progressing to construct the new public realm on Albert Street between Mary and Charlotte streets.

From **Monday 2 February 2026 for up to eight weeks**, a new work area will be established on Albert Street between Mary and Elizabeth streets (refer to map below).

Work will be carried out during day and night, seven days a week, subject to weather and unforeseen circumstances.


Work has been staged to maintain access to businesses and properties. Access to businesses will remain open during business operating hours.

Construction activities:

- Installing barriers and adjusting existing hoarding.
- Removing and installing street furniture.
- Locating underground services, including saw cutting, core drilling, pot holing and hydro excavation.
- Demolishing asphalt, concrete, kerbs and excavation.
- Installing new drainage, kerbs, concrete slab and paving.
- Installing lighting and traffic signals.

What to expect:

- Changes to pedestrian access during day and night.
- Traffic control and signage in place to assist.
- Work occurring during both day and night shifts.
- Increased noise, dust, vibration and worksite lighting.
- Potential impacts to existing services (e.g. power, water, gas). Affected properties will be notified if required.
