## Hope Island station construction update

Finishing works and site reinstatement activities are progressing at Hope Island station, along with testing and commissioning activities in preparation for station opening.

The Cross River Rail Delivery Authority and Acciona Georgiou Joint Venture (AGJV) would like to thank the local community for their ongoing patience during construction.

The following activities will take place in April, between 7:00am and 5:00pm Monday to Saturday (weather and site conditions permitting). Some intermittent activities will also be required at night on Hope Island Road between 7:00pm and 5:00am Sunday to Thursday.

### Ongoing minor works

- Platform and station finishing works
- Landscaping and minor maintenance activities
- Traffic signal works, line marking and footpath works on Hope Island Road (night works)
- Removal of materials and equipment from the site office compound, and reinstatement works.

### Testing and commissioning activities

Testing and commissioning activities will continue across the station precinct on electrical, mechanical and other station systems.

### What to expect

- Daytime testing of platform and lift announcements systems may be heard at times
- Lighting will be progressively switched on and tested. During testing, lights may appear brighter for extended periods of time
- When testing is complete, permanent station lighting will be operational
- Construction vehicle movements to and from site to remove materials and equipment
- The use of machinery including elevated work platforms, excavators, trucks, cranes, water carts, compaction equipment, line marking equipment and other hand-held tools.

### Rail corridor works

Track resurfacing works are scheduled **between 12:00am and 5:00am on Friday 24 April 2026**. This activity can only be safely completed when no trains are running. Residents may hear the rail machinery as it moves along the line past their properties.

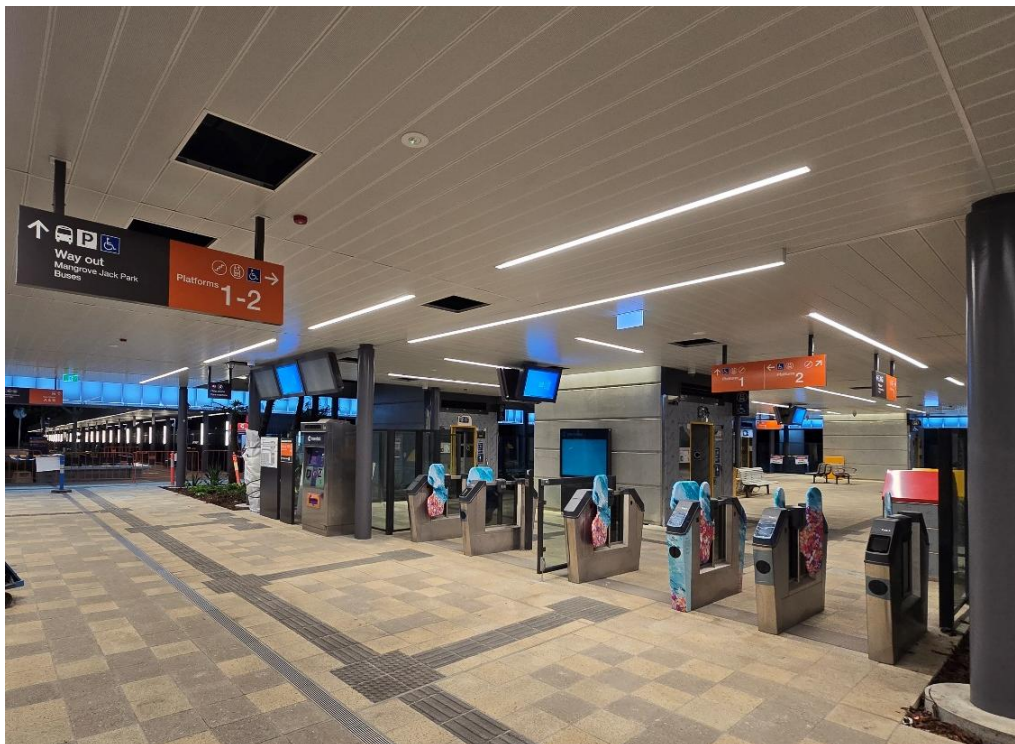
These new stations will provide the local community with greater access to convenient rail services, expanding options for easy travel within the Gold Coast, as well as to Brisbane.
