## UPDATED: Construction update Dutton Park station

During April and May 2026, some intermittent finishing works will continue near Kent Street, including minor patching, sealing, concrete repairs and ongoing landscaping maintenance.

Work will also continue within the rail corridor during planned track closures, including the installation of overhead electrical structures, signalling equipment, cable routes and drainage installation.

### Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during April and May 2026, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Finishing works including minor patching, sealing, concrete repairs and ongoing landscaping maintenance near Kent Street
- Continue works within the rail corridor including the installation of overhead electrical structures, signalling equipment, cable routes and drainage between Ensign Avenue and the Southern Tunnel Portal
- Continue earthworks, drainage installation, rail maintenance access road construction and minor landscaping works at Fenton Street.

### Out of hours work

Work activities scheduled during planned track closures (when trains are not operating) or outside the project's standard working hours are outlined below, weather and construction conditions permitting.

### What to expect

During these works you will notice some disruptions such as:

- Intermittent temporary lane closures on Fenton Street and Ensign Avenue to facilitate access into the rail corridor. Traffic management will be set up to manage an increase in vehicle movements in these areas. Please follow the direction of traffic control and signage and allow for extra time to travel
- Increased noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment
- Trucks and machinery including concrete trucks and pumps, frontend loaders, excavators with rock breakers, vacuum trucks, piling rigs, mobile cranes, small power tools, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night.

### Changes to the way you travel

Due to **protected industrial action over the Easter long weekend**, the scheduled track closures have been **extended until Thursday 30 April** (an extra four days). This extension will allow critical works on multiple major rail projects to be undertaken safely and efficiently.
