UPDATE - Roma Street – Temporary eastbound lane and footpath changes

Work is continuing on the northern side of Roma Street to finalise the footpath and driveway in front of the Western Services Building, with completion expected by mid-2026.

To support these activities, staged changes to traffic, pedestrian and public transport stops will occur on Roma Street between Garrick and Countess streets.

Work details:

- Construction of a new footpath and driveway on the northern side of Roma Street in front of the new Western Services Building.
- Implementing traffic control arrangements.
- Temporary closure of a section of the northern footpath with a detour in place.
- Intermittent day and night lane closures. Vehicle access through the area will remain open.

Traffic and pedestrian changes

- Access to bus stops 124 (Stop ID: 000124) and 125 (Stop ID: 000125) will be maintained at all times.
- Outside of peak hours, the eastbound (inbound) lane on Roma Street between Garrick and Countess streets will be temporarily closed. Eastbound access will be maintained for vehicles.
- Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist motorists, cyclists and pedestrians.

Work hours

Construction activities and the associated footpath closure will occur during day and night shift (24/7).

Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.

What to expect

- Use of equipment including road saws and jackhammers, vacuum excavation trucks, generators, lighting towers and hand tools.
- Increased noise, dust, light and vibration. Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum.
- Increased deliveries, movement of plant, machinery and equipment.
- Increase in personnel carrying out work.

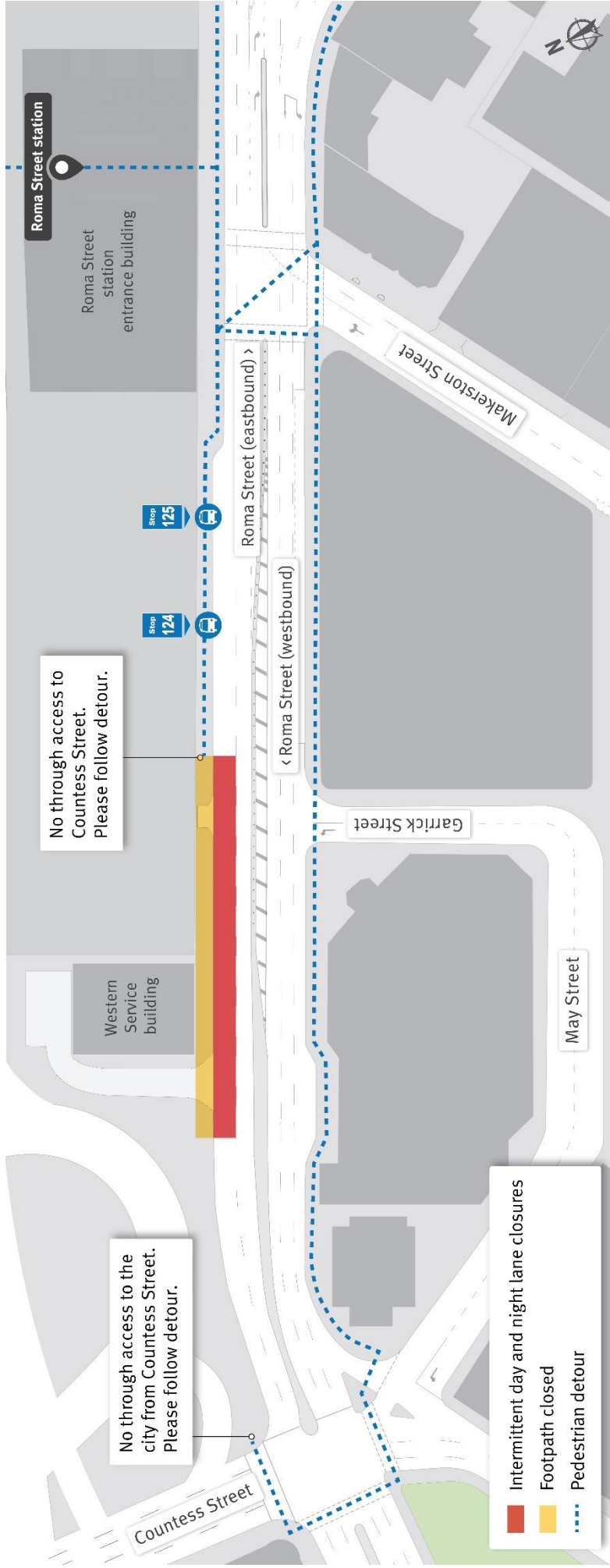
